*Facts about Addiction*

- ✚ *Persons with substance use disorders come from all walks of life.*
- ✚ *Substance use changes the brain, which can make drug use compulsive.*
- ✚ *Addiction is a chronic disease that can be managed. Treatment works, people recover.*
- ✚ *Medication-assisted treatment, coupled with counseling, is the preferred treatment for heroin and other opioids.*
- ✚ *Many people struggling with substance use require longer-term and/or repeated treatment.*
- ✚ *Relapse is common and presents a learning opportunity.*

**Respond to potential overdoses – and save a life.**

*Use of heroin or opioids, or drugs laced with these substances, increase the risk for overdose. If someone has overdosed, **FIRST CALL 911**. If you have been trained, perform CPR. Naloxone (Narcan) can reverse an opioid overdose. If someone you know is at risk for an opioid overdose, you may want a naloxone kit. Visit [nkyhealth.org](https://nkyhealth.org) for locations.*

**Injection drug use increases a person's risk of becoming infected with hepatitis C and HIV.**

*Syringe access exchange programs are one tool to reduce the threat of infectious disease spread through drug injection equipment, as well as a way to connect people who inject drugs to treatment resources and other health services.
